- Coach the skills required ensuring sessions and the programme are player centred
- Motivate and encourage all players
- Utilise all personnel, resources and technology available including video analysis to ensure the programme is as good as it can be
- When coaching students aged under 18, understand and follow the DSE's child protection procedures at all times.
- Liaise with the Director of Netball as and when required e.g. provide reports, attendance updates, feedback from participants etc.
